

Budget News for January 13, 2009

The Governor's 2009-2010 Budget for Education included a proposal that impacts our current year, reduction of current year revenue limit. These reductions were anticipated by RVSD and will not translate to RVSD cuts in this school year. The District can meet expenses through June because we have a 5% reserve in the budget for economic uncertainty.

The Budget Advisory Committee meets Thursday, January 22, 2009, at 4:00 – 5:15 p.m. at the District Office to discuss possible reductions for the 2009-2010 budget year.

Highlights from the Board Meeting of Thursday, January 8, 2009

- The Board heard a budget update on the Governor's preview of his proposed budget for 2009-2010. Parents expressed concern about the effects it may have on RVSD funding. The Board will place on a future agenda discussion of raising additional revenue for the District.
- The Board adopted policies on Personnel, Students, Instruction and Facilities. The Board also approved a contract to have policies posted on line through CSBA Policy Services.
- The Interdistrict policies were reviewed. March 1st is now the deadline for priority registration for students new to the district.
