The Ross Valley School District summer school program has been cancelled this year due to state budget constraints. Special Education summer school will continue as scheduled.

Budget News for May 5, 2009

The propositions on the May 19th special election ballot will directly affect funding for education as well as other critical services in the state. Each of the six measures is a compromise between Democrats, Republicans, Independents and the Governor. Each has positive aspects and a negative side as well. Democrats, Republicans and Independents are all divided on their support for the propositions, and the Education Coalition is split on several of the propositions. Polling on the chances of the propositions passing is very poor. If the propositions don't pass, the state will have an additional \$6 billion in cuts to make to the 2009-2010 budget that is already \$8 billion in the red. I urge all of you to vote on May 19th. If the ballot propositions do not pass, we need to send a clear message to the legislators that, no matter how much money is available in the state budget, education must be given the top priority in the use of funds we do have.*
