We reviewed the API/AYP results with explanations on program improvement. Brookside had strong gains across the board in both ELA and Math. In the subgroup of students with learning disabilities, our students, however, are not meeting the current target. We are in year one of Program Improvement under the No Child Left Behind act.

Concerns:

- Exercise less
- More sedentary
- Body image teasing – concern
- More time spent alone at home
- Been hit or pushed
- Cyberbullying – concern
- Rumor spreading among girls
- Boys feel less safe at school/home
- Meaningful participation at home and at school– why so low?

Strengths:

- School protective factors
- Teachers treat students fairly
- Feel more connected to school than home?
- 95% plan to go to college – matching high expectations
