The safety of students while at school is our most important concern. Even so accidents do happen and resulting medical treatment can be very expensive.

Ross Valley School District does not provide accident medical insurance for school related injuries, but we have joined with thousands of other schools though out California to provide access to a low-cost voluntary insurance program. The program is arranged and administered by Myers-Stevens and Toohey Company, an organization that has specialized in student accident medical insurance for over 40 years.

Several programs are offered, as indicated on the attached brochures. If you'd like to participate, you can either complete the enrollment form on-line through the Myers-Stevens link provided or print the attached enrollment form and submit it. Both enrollment methods require your payment be made directly to Myers-Stevens and Toohey per their instructions. We recommend you keep the brochure in a safe place for quick and easy reference.
