Ross Valley School District does not provide accident medical insurance for school related injuries, but we have joined with thousands of other schools throughout California to provide you access to a low-cost voluntary insurance program. The program is arranged and administered by Myers-Stevens and Toohey Company, an organization that has specialized in student accident medical insurance for over 40 years.

If you'd like to participate, complete the attached enrollment form and submit it, along with your payment, directly to Myers-Stevens and Toohey per their instructions.
